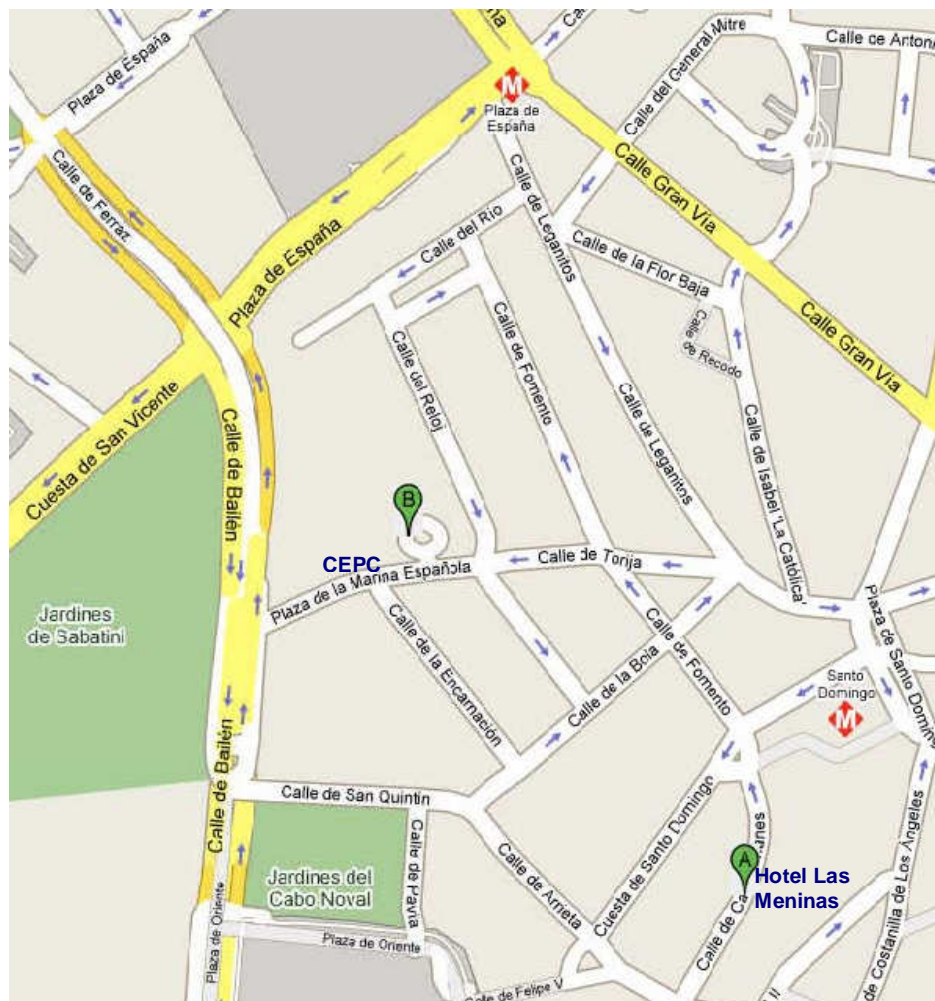




**Practical information**

“Meninas” is included in the Historic United of “Recinto de la Villa de Madrid” in the “Austrias” neighbourhood. Close to the Opera Theatre, the pedestrian area of Oriente Square, the Royal Palace, the Convent of “Descalzas Reales”, the Convent of “Encarnación”. A few steps of “Plaza Mayor”, Gran Vía, “Puerta Del Sol”, the main shopping centres and close to museums that form the famous triangle of art: Prado, Thyssen and Reina Sofía. **The Hotel is also located very close to CEPC, where the workshop will be held** (Plaza de la Marina Española, 9 - five minutes walking distance).

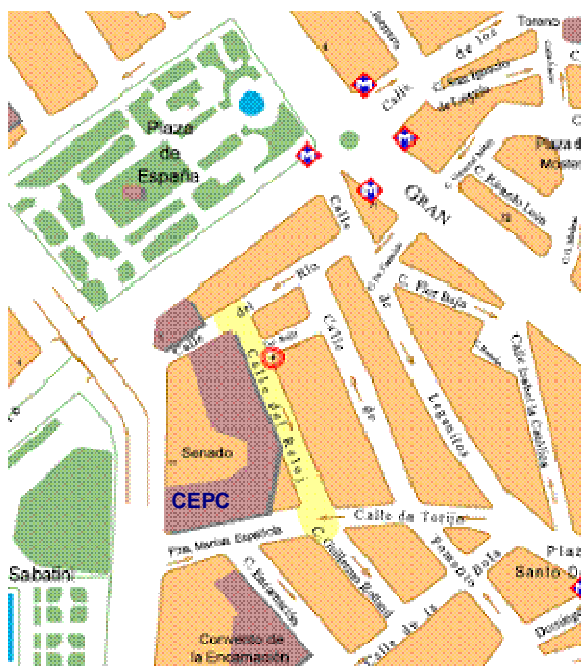
